Educational Kerner:

Tonight I write this with a heavy heart, its 11/18/11 and Dodie and I were notified that our Chapter has lost another. We lost Steve Kershaw earlier this year. On the lighter side, I was reading this month's Wing World I find an article by Bob Berry, Former Director of Rider Courses, on buyer beware. He talks about jackets and how they are made and what to look for when buying one. He also talks about siding on the pavement and how long material will last. Denim jean material will last approximately 0.6 seconds while a single layer of 1.4mm cowhide will last 5.8 seconds. He goes on about how the outer layer of clothing should be able to protect you from penetration of sharp objects. He leaves the decision up to you on what to buy, but remember it's your hide you want to protect. Investigate before you buy, and buy the jacket and trousers that you wish and will perform well in critical times. Till next time, keep the rubber on the road and the wind in your face
